Master Tang's Pak-Mei Kung-Fu and Lion Dance Troupe

Master Cho -Tak Tang came to the UK from Hong Kong in the early 1970's he was highly commended by he's master to teach Pak-Mei and permitted to expand and develop the Kung-Fu style overseas. As well as teaching Kung-Fu master Tang also taught Traditional Southern Chinese Lion Dancing and performed all over the world.

Lion dance is traditionally used to represent Kung-Fu schools and the style of Kung-Fu can be seen in the dancers' movements and foot work. Master Tang is now retired and residing in Hong Kong now but he's legacy continues. 



MERCY Humanitarian United Kingdom, MHUK, is a London based non-governmental organisation established in 2014.

Our mission is to provide compassionate medical and humanitarian aid to communities in dire need.

We are a sister organisation to Malaysian Medical Relief Society in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.


MHUK projects include

~conducting cleft lip and palate operations for underprivileged children ~raising awareness and providing crucial support on mental health for university students

~deploying medical and humanitarian emergency relief to communities affected by natural disasters and conflicts

~distributing essential food and non-food items to the homeless and those in need, especially during the winter months











MHUK team conducted it's first cleft lip and palate surgeries in Phnom Penh, Cambodia, in January 2020 at the Khmer Soviet Friendship Hospital.

The medical volunteers of 10 (which include surgeons, anaesthetists and nurses) operated on 32 children (after screening 100 children)

They were 15 primary cases with cleft lip and palate, and 17 with revisional surgeries.

MHUK team also provided hands on training for all local team members based at the hospital, sharing their knowledge on infection control aspects.

They looked after the patients pre- and post-operatively, reviewed them through to discharge, and parents were given after care advice.

The team hope their humble mission put smiles on the children faces and their families, something they have been dreaming of for many years.

This will also allow the children to be able to have better speech and communication, to integrate in their society.

MHUK also help to improve their aesthetics and functionality such as the ability to eat and drink; as well as minimalize aspirations, chest infections and social isolation.

Each year, up to 250,000 babies are born worldwide with cleft lip or palate or both.


Most of them are from low income families and live in countries with reduced resources.

Approximately 75% of these children's treatments are funded by NGOs.









Cleft Anomalies Surgery Mission at Nepal Cleft and Burn Center, Kirtipur Hospital, Kathmandu, Nepal from 28th February – 8th March 2024.

A significant number of cleft lip and palate cases require secondary surgeries and after care.

The MHUK team will assess a number of children and young adults at the hospital before doing the cleft anomalies surgery.

Additionally the MHUK team will be sharing their knowledge and skills with the local team in Kathmandu.

The three surgeons will be presenting academic teaching on secondary surgeries, its complications and follow up care.

The medical team of 10 volunteers consists of 3 experienced surgeons who has done thousands of cleft and other facial anomaly surgeries, 2 anesthetists, 4 paediatric cleft nurses and 1 General Practitioner who works in acute medicine and in paediatric surgery.

The team will be led by Mrs Ranji Kent, a trustee for MHUK, with 45 years of experience as a paediatric cleft nurse and humanitarian work.






Duan Zhenzhen

Performing Chinese Mongolian Dance




